## School Supply List for Fourth Grade for 2016-2017

*Welcome to Fourth Grade! We're glad to have you at LCS. Please see <http://misscrachi.com/back.html#supplies> for clarification on some items*

**Daily:** Healthy snack (fruit, veggies, crackers and cheese, pretzels, popcorn), a water bottle that completely closes (*not one with a cap, please, because it's easy for those to spill; please drop the bottle you get to make sure it doesn't open because we have had a lot of spills during the year*)

**Household:** -1 box of facial tissues

-1 bag of individually-wrapped candy (ex: Blow pops, Jolly Ranchers, Airheads, Dum-Dum pops, Smarties, etc.): can get at the Dollar Store

**Academic:** Please put your name on everything possible.

- **A LOT** of #2 pencils, sharpened (I suggest mechanical pencils.)
- small pencil sharpener with a shavings catcher
- Large eraser, Red pens or pencils, Calculator with basic 4 operations, Scissors
- 1 pack of colored pencils (*an 8-pack is fine*)
- 3 marble composition books (3 different colors if possible): one for science and social studies (red or orange), one for language arts (blue), one for math (green)
- One 2 inch 3-ring binder (any color) (must fit all folders, pencil pouch, and planner that the school provides)
- Zippered pencil pouch that goes in a binder – for pencils, pens, erasers, scissors, calculator, colored pencils (if they fit) (*put in the front of the binder*)
- 7 folders with side pockets and 3 holes: Please try to get one of each of these colors and label them and put them into the binder in this order (except the yellow): Home/School (unique one: label one side "Goes Home" and the other half "Goes to School"), Bible (purple), language arts (blue), math (green), science (red), social studies (orange), "Stays in School" (yellow)
- 1 pack of 8.5x11" lined paper (*please use regular paper, not paper torn from a notebook since that creates a mess; put this into the binder behind the folders*)
- index cards (*with lines on one side is best*)
- Spiral bound sketch book: 8-1/2" x 11" or 9" x 12", 70# weight for art class
- 12-inch ruler with metric on one edge, inches on the other (*do not get one that bends because it will quickly become inaccurate; make sure the inch side has lines of various sizes- see misscrachi.com*)
- a Bible (*you don't need to buy a new one but if you need to get one, please get one without tabs and with a concordance in the back if possible- the NIV Adventure Bible that many students have is a good one*)
- a small Merriam-Webster dictionary (*to keep in your desk*)
- earbuds for tech class
