



#### HEALTH OFFICE INFORMATION:

# End of the year reminders:

\*Please be certain to pick up your child's medication in the health office on their last day of school. All medication left at school must be disposed of. \*New York State education Law requires that each student receive a physical exam when entering a school district for the first time and again in grades PK, K, 2, 4, 7 and 10.

\*All letters were mailed home in March with regards to new immunization requirements for students entering grades 6, 7 and 12. If you did NOT receive a letter from the health office, your child is up to date on vaccines.

\*All required immunizations must be documented by your child's physician and submitted to the LCS health office no later than the first day of school.

\*All medications that are needed at school, prescription and over the counter, require a MD order and parental permission. The medication must be in a prescription bottle with the pharmacy label attached.

For older students, if you would like your child to be able to carry and self administer their medications, the MD must indicate that on his medication order. Written parental permission is required as well.

\*If your child is going to play a fall sport please be sure to check with their MD, or the health office before the end of the school year, to be sure their physical exam report will still be current in August. There will be a Nurse in the health office in August to review the physical forms. You will be called if your child needs an updated physical. It is very difficult to get an immediate appointment with M.D.'s at times, causing students to have to sit out of practices and sometimes games until their updated physical is submitted to the health office.

Physicals can be mailed or FAXED to the attention of the School Nurse during the summer months to the main office at (518) 935-2258.
