Dear LCS Family,

About a month ago while I was sharing with a colleague I made the statement, "I trust that if I sense the Lord is leading me to step out to something different, I will have the courage to follow." Two hours later I received an email that said, "We are in desperate need of a middle school math teacher at Alliance Academy International in Quito, Ecuador. Would you consider coming and teaching at AAI?" As I read the email it was if the Lord was standing behind me with His hand on my shoulder saying, "Did you truly mean what you said?"

Needless to say, I felt like I had no choice but to pursue the opportunity. The Lord has confirmed that He was leading in this path in multiple ways over the past few weeks. I can say with confidence that this is what the Lord wants me to do next year.

While I am excited about the opportunity and a bit overwhelmed by the challenge, I am also clinging to God's promise given in Philippians 4:6-9, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. I will be going to Ecuador as a volunteer and that takes me even further outside of my comfort zone but I know God is faithful. I would appreciate your prayers as I finish out the school, assemble my team of prayer and financial supporters and head to Ecuador this summer.
