SCHOOL CLOSINGS

Here in the northeast from time to time we find it necessary to close school due to the weather and hazardous driving conditions. When this occurs, we will do our best to get the information out to you as soon as possible.

If school is closed in the morning, here are the means by which you can/will obtain the information:

- Local TV stations will post the closing on their morning broadcasts and on their websites. (WRGB- CBS 6 will send you a text notice if you sign up on their website.)

AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES CANCELLED

If a storm arrives during the day, Loudonville Christian School will not close early due to the number of school districts represented in our student body. Your local school district may close, however, and pick your children up early. Unless we hear from parents, students will be sent home on their bus. It's important to be on the alert to this possibility. On days such as these, Loudonville Christian School may find it necessary to cancel ALL after school activities. This includes games, practices, clubs, review classes, etc. Cancellation information will be found by viewing:

The LCS Annual School Spelling Bee will be held on Thursday, December 7th in the Ministry Center at 9:00am. Our student participants are as follows:

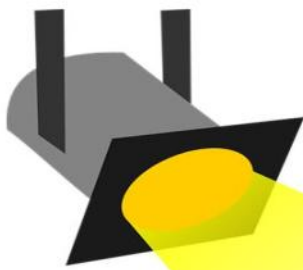

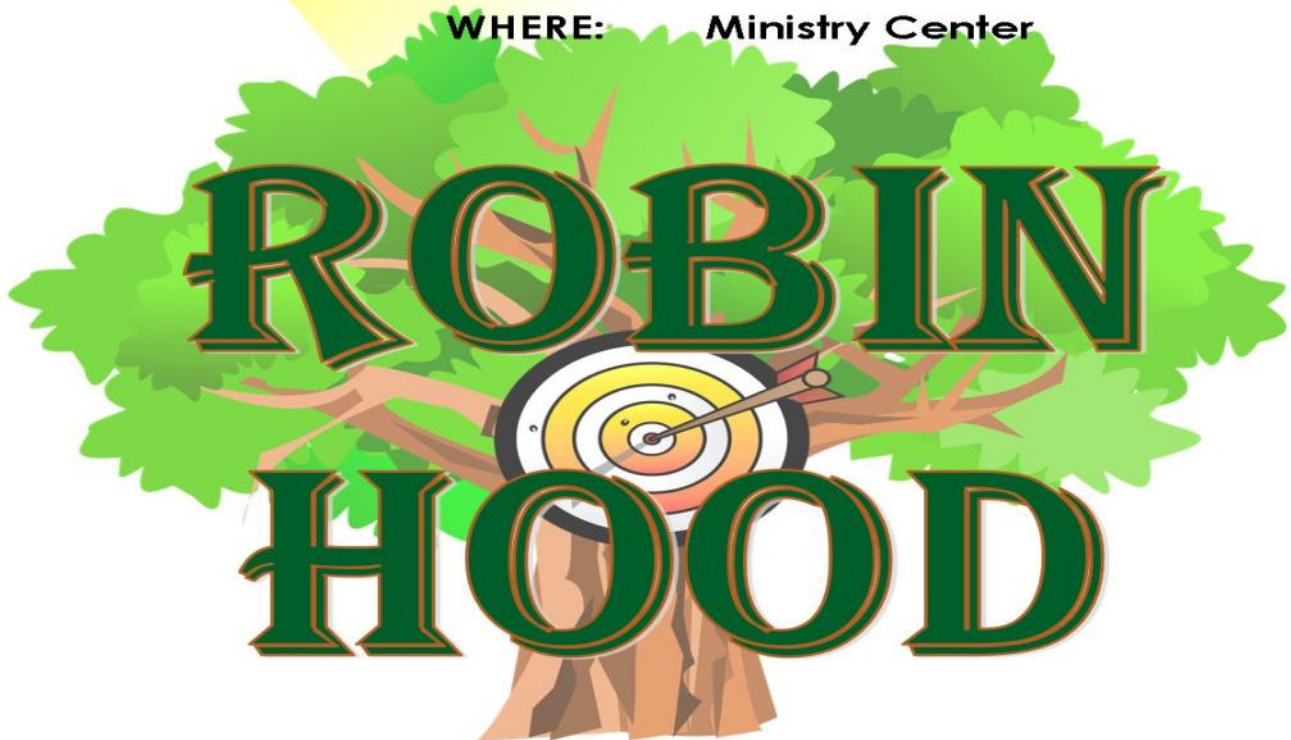
