AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES CANCELLED

If a storm arrives during the day, Loudonville Christian School will not close early due to the number of school districts represented in our student body. However, your local school district may close, and pick your children up early. Unless we hear from parents, students will be sent home on their bus. It's important to be on the alert to this possibility. On days such as these, Loudonville Christian School may find it necessary to cancel ALL after school activities.
