

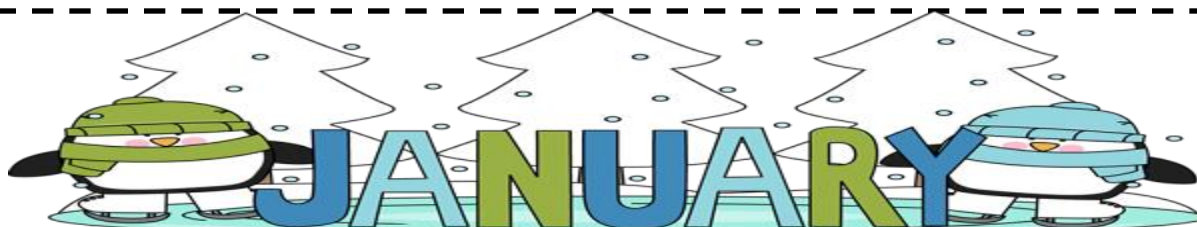

## **DRESS DOWN NOTES:**

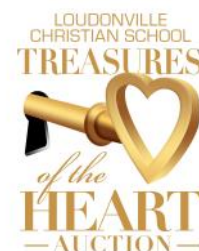
Upper school students may dress down for exams

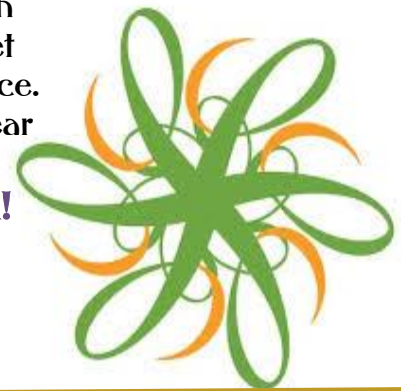


## Please help support LCS by shopping at Colonie Center!
