Questar Students



All students who receive their textbooks through Questar will receive an email from Questar when their order is complete. At that point, parents may pick up textbooks directly from Questar. This method is preferred by Questar, so the parents can verify the order. Questar does check orders, but mistakes can happen! The parents of students are ultimately responsible for the loan and return of textbooks issued, making the email is also useful at the end of the year when it is time to return the textbooks. If textbooks are not picked up, Questar will deliver them to our school in September.

DRESS CODE CHANGES FOR 2016-2017

We no longer have a rule against screen print for any grades. However clothing shall not include items or print that advertise or promote values contrary to the biblical values of LCS.

Girls' shorts can be mid-thigh or longer as long as they are not loose fitting or athletic shorts.

Shorts can be worn at any time of the year but not athletic shorts.

Girls' skirts or dresses can be no more than 2 inches above the top of the knee.

Skin tight pants such as leggings, jeggings, yoga pants, etc...may not be worn unless they are worn with a skirt, dress or shirt that reaches to at least mid-thigh in front and back.
