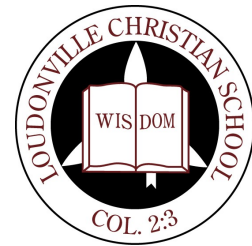

Founded in 1960 as a K— 8 co-educational day school, Loudonville Christian School (LCS) has existed to provide the highest quality Christian education, marked by a level of academic excellence that is thorough and committed to high scholastic standards. Expansion to a full high school program began in 1995, and the first senior class graduated in June of 1999.

LCS is an evangelical, interdenominational school which serves families who place an emphasis on higher education and supports over 70 churches in the Capital Region. The campus is conveniently located just outside of Albany yet nestled in the beautiful community of Loudonville, NY. The LCS building is equipped with 3 science labs, 1 technology lab, and full gymnasium.

Technology

Loudonville Christian School desires to provide ample opportunity for students to learn in a technology rich way. Our technology classes begin at the PK level and are continued through high school. Our 9th–12th grades utilize iPads for textbooks and coursework. Beyond the classroom, our teachers provide opportunities for students to reinforce their learning and building skills relevant to our culture.

Education Made Mobile

LCS utilizes RenWeb and Moodle Learning Management Systems. By accessing RenWeb, parents are provided real time communication for coursework and grades. Moodle LMS allows our teachers to creatively develop and tailor their courses from a Biblical worldview, while meeting appropriate standards and reinforcing the need for student interaction with technology within the learning environment. Parents and students have the ability to access both systems.
