



Frequently Asked Questions

1. What are the school day hours?

LCS' school hours are from 7:55 am to 2:48 pm. We offer early drop off at 7:30 am and provide coverage for late pick up by 5:30 pm.

2. Do you provide after care?

LCS is pleased to offer After Care until 5:30 pm for students in grades PK to 6th for use as needed. The hourly charge is \$6.00 per hour and child per each day used. For students in grades 7 to 12, we offer afterschool study hall until 5:30 pm for no additional charge.

3. Do students need to wear a uniform?

No. LCS implements the use of Dress Code that maintains modesty and appropriateness.

4. Can my child spend some time at LCS?

Yes. We encourage students to visit our campus and spend some time in the classroom with their peer group. For younger students, this may be just a portion of the school day, while older students (grades 3 to 12) should plan to spend a full day with us.

5. Is LCS an accredited school?

Yes. Loudonville is dually accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and with Middle States Association. Loudonville is also approved by the New York State Board of Regents.

6. What curriculum does LCS use?

Teachers at LCS utilize a variety of Christian and secular texts to develop rich content for all subjects. All curriculum is reviewed to ensure it meets or exceeds state standards, and all subjects are taught from a Christian worldview.

7. What is the cost of tuition?

8. Does LCS offer financial aid?

LCS extends financial aid on a first-come, first-serve basis, so we encourage families to begin the process as early as possible.

10. Are there any deadlines for applying for admission?

LCS offers a rolling admissions process to new applicants, but maintains priority to our current families. Current families are required to re-enroll for the following school year by February 28th.
